Honolulu



Income Assistance

- **Organization: Salvation Army Community Assistance Center**
 - **Program: Financial Assistance for Kupuna 62+**
 - Hawaii kupuna ages 62+ facing eviction or disconnected utilities due to financial need may be eligible for up to \$1000 in direct assistance payable to the landlord or utility company.
 - **Program: Financial Assistance for Kupuna Ages 70+**
 - Hawaii Kupuna in financial need age 70+ living with a physical or mental illness may be eligible for up to \$500 in direct assistance payable to the vendor or service company.



Housing /Shelter

- **Organization: YWCA O'ahu**
 - **Program : Fernhurst Residence:**
 - provide a temporary and supportive home where gifted women live and work.
 - **Eligibility:**
 - Single Female
 - Resident of Oahu for last 3 months
 - Homeless, imminent risk of homelessness and/or difficulty covering living expenses and basic needs

Transportation

- **Organization: HCEOC**
 - **Program: Kaho'okele Transportation**
 - Offers a shared ride curb to curb service for eligible Hawaii Island residents Service areas include Hamakua, Honoka'a, Keaau, upper and lower Puna, Mountain View and Kailua Kona.
 - Individuals must meet age, disability, or income criteria



Housing/Shelter

- **Hope Services**
 - **Program: Hope Services Outreach Program**
 - Hope Services outreach program engages with people experiences homelessness disconnected from available resources. They may be living on the streets, in cars, in the bushes, or in emergency shelters. We assist them in accessing health, housing, and social services. Even if we can't get them into shelter right away, we follow up with them, keeping in regular contact as we work together toward permanent housing

Utilities

- **Organization: L.E.I Foundation**
 - **Program: Lifeline Program**
 - Lifeline is a federal assistance program, created by the FCC that helps provide affordable phone service to eligible low-income households. At this time we can provide clients with federal programs to receive a free cell phone with 1,000 min talk, unlimited texts. And 4.5 gigs of data-specific criteria apply



Housing & Shelter

- **Organization: Council for Native Hawaiian Advancement**
 - **Program: DHHL Kupuna Program Rental Assistance**
 - In partnership with DHHL the Council for Native Hawaiian Advancement (CNHA) is offering rental subsidies to eligible Kupuna (ages 62 or older) on the DHHL Wait List in Hawai'i. These subsidies will help ensure that Kupuna in need can remain securely housed in their current rentals while positioning themselves to accept a DHHL Lease once they are awarded
